

USCAH Checklist: Creating Your Roadmap for Return to Campus

Category 4: Programming and Education—Medical Personnel, Students, Coaches and Staff

The following criteria should be used as a guideline for the development and implementation of all return to sport participation education and programming.

1. Education must be relevant to each specific group

- Healthcare Professionals
- Student Athletes
- Coaches
- Staff

2. Education should be applied consistently for all groups

- Establish an education committee
- Only Committee members provide education and training
- Choose e-learning platform to deliver content

3. Plan for education should be transparent - 360 degrees

- Publish all education and programming content on your institution website
- Distribute education and programming plan to athletic department staff and institution leadership

4. Recommend assessment following education

- E-learning platform must have assessment capabilities for content mastery
- E-Learning platform must provide access to education modules via smart phones and tablets

5. Recommend attestation following education

- Confirmation each individual and group has reviewed the information
- Confirmation each individual and group understands their specific responsibilities
- Provide additional resources when requested
- Provide dedicated staff—Education Committee—to answer questions and to provide clarity

6. Programming and Education

- Includes training, rehearsals, and frequent reviews
- Meets institutional, local, state and federal guidelines
- Content is consistent with Institutional programming



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
